Mail ballots will be sent beginning the week of Oct. 14 to voters who have signed up to receive them. Voters may also opt to cast a ballot at one of several Voter Service and Polling Center locations. Ballots must be received by the Boulder County Clerk & Recorder or designated drop-off location by 7 p.m. on Election Day in order for your vote(s) to be counted. Ballots received after 7 p.m. on Election Day will not be counted. Postmarks do not count as a received date.

Mail ballot voters: After voting, check your voter information at www.BoulderCountyVotes.org to verify your ballot was received. If you make a mistake, damage or lose your ballot, you may request a replacement ballot by emailing Vote@BoulderCountyVotes.org or by calling 303-413-7740.
