PRIMARY ELECTION INFORMATION

Elections in Colorado are conducted by mail ballot with select Voter Service and Polling Center locations for those that require additional assistance or prefer to vote in person. See below for a list of locations and hours of operation.

For this Primary Election, ballots will be mailed the week of June 2 to eligible voters who are members of the Republican, Democratic and American Constitution parties. Additionally, the City of Longmont is conducting a Special Election. All eligible City of Longmont voters will receive a ballot with the Longmont question regardless of party affiliation. Unaffiliated voters throughout Boulder County may affiliate with a major political party and vote in a primary up to and including Primary Election Day on June 24.

Ballots must be received by the Boulder County Clerk & Recorder or designated drop-off location by 7 p.m. on Primary Election Day in order for your vote(s) to be counted. Ballots received after 7 p.m. on Primary Election Day will not be counted. Postmarks do not count as a received date.

After returning a ballot, voters can verify that their ballot was received by visiting BoulderCountyVotes.org.

If you make a mistake, damage or lose your ballot, you may request a replacement ballot by emailing Vote@BoulderCountyVotes.org, calling 303-413-7740, or by visiting a Voter Service and Polling Center.
