RE: SU-96-18 — Activity on Parcels Prevented Lapsing

Dear Dale:

We write to you on behalf of our client, Martin Marietta Materials, Inc. ("Martin Marietta") to describe why Martin Marietta's Special Use Permit SU-96-18 (the "Permit") has not lapsed. SU-96-18 was enacted by Boulder County Resolution 98-32 on August 20, 1998 ("Resolution 98-32"). The parties also entered into a development agreement dated June 30, 1999 ("Development Agreement"), governing operations pursuant to the Permit. The passage of SU-96-18 consolidated and reauthorized numerous prior County approvals, including those under Docket Nos. SU-69-476, SU-84-18, SU-90-26, and SU-92-02. See map attached as Appendix A.

Under Boulder County law, a permit can lapse in two ways, neither of which is applicable here. First, the Code provides that "[a]ny approved use by Special Review that does not significantly commence operation or construction as described and approved in a building permit on any portion of the special use permit within five calendar years after the Board has approved the use, shall lapse" BCLUC, § 4-604(B). This provision is inapplicable here, because of the numerous activities occurring on the site associated with the Permit within five years after approval of the Development Agreement, as listed in Appendix B. These activities include active mining operations at the Miller Pit, the seeding of Miller Lakes 2 and 4, and the maintenance of permits through submission of annual reports and applicable fees. Moreover, the County confirmed that the Permit had not lapsed under this provision: "We have determined that this special use permit has not expired for failure to commence activity under the permit, since the approval of Docket SU-96-18 also repealed and reinstated Dockets SU-69-476 and SU-80-26, which were the previous approvals of the 'Rockin' WP' and the 'Miller Pit' where mining has occurred." Letter from David Callahan to Steven Brown, at 1-2 (Oct. 17, 2006); *see also* Letter from Abby Shannon to Summer Howard, at 1 (Jan. 24, 2017) (stating that the 2006 letter "remains in effect"). Accordingly, lapsing has not occurred under the Code's Section 604(B).

A permit can also lapse if there is no activity on any portion of the special use permit for any five-year period. Specifically, the Code provides:

Any approved use by Special Review which commences operation or construction as required under Subsection (B), immediately above, shall lapse, and shall be of no further force and effect, if the use is inactive for any continuous five-year period or such shorter

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time as may be prescribed elsewhere in this code or in a condition of a specific docket's approval. . . . An approved special use shall be deemed inactive under this Subsection (C) if there has been no activity under any portion of the special use permit for a continuous period of five years or more. . . ."

BCLUC, § 4-604(C) (emphasis added).

Accordingly, a permit will not lapse under this provision if there is *any* activity on *any* parcel of the permitted land at *any* point within any five-year period to prevent lapsing from occurring. Martin Marietta easily satisfies this low threshold. Appendix B provides a cumulative list of SU-96-18-related activities. These activities include mining, active reclamation, preparation and submission of numerous annual reports and fees, conducting stormwater inspections and submitting applicable fees, performing water quality testing, conducting an irrigation ditch improvement feasibility study, perfecting water rights, and reseeding and weed control. Martin Marietta has easily satisfied the requirements of Section 4-604 to prevent the Permit from lapsing—there have been numerous activities on several different portions of the area governed by the Permit every year since enactment of the Development Agreement.

The listed activities were all required under Martin Marietta's permits. Specifically, the Permit states in condition 4; "The applicant shall obtain all applicable permits as required and necessary. . . . The operation of any aspect of this proposal that does not comply with the terms and condition of all required permits shall be grounds for a revocation hearing before the Board of County Commissioners." Thus, the Permit requires Martin Marietta to maintain and comply with all other permits.

Martin Marietta operates under Colorado Department of Reclamation, Mining and Safety ("DRMS") Permit No. M-1974-015 for parcels SU-69-476 and SU-84-18. A condition of the DRMS permit is to submit annual reports to the state, which Martin Marietta has done every year. Martin Marietta is also required to maintain the reclamation bond by the DRMS permit, which also has been done on an annual basis. The State also requires Martin Marietta to submit an annual stormwater report, with routine inspections and occasional renewal applications. The same occurs for the state air permit. All of this is documented on an annual basis as identified in the Appendix B.

Moreover, under the DRMS permit and under state law, Martin Marietta must reclaim mined sites pursuant to technical design criteria. *See, e.g.*, C.R.S. § 34-32.5-116. Martin Marietta's predecessor-in-interest completed active mining on these parcels and was in the process of reclamation activities when Martin Marietta acquired the property. Following the acquisition, the 2013 flood inundated the lakes with gravel and disturbed the required reclamation design features, including the specified slope angles, reclamation contours, bank setbacks, topsoil, and revegetation. Martin Marietta must address the results of this flood and reclaim the entire site before its bond can be released. Before this can occur, Martin Marietta is required to demonstrate that vegetation equivalent to 80% of the surrounding vegetation has been established in the reclaimed area. Thus, the seeding, inter-seeding, weed control, irrigation, and other measures listed in Appendix B are all activities required by the DRMS permit. Marietta has been meeting with the property owner, Boulder County Parks and Open Space, to discuss the issue of reclamation since February 2015.

Finally, the decision in *Sierra Club v. Billingsley*, 166 P.3d 309 (Colo. App. 2007), supports our conclusion that the Permit has not lapsed due to inactivity. In *Billingsley*, Boulder County granted a special use permit to Cemex's predecessor-in-interest, Southwestern Portland Cement Co., to burn discarded tires as fuel for cement manufacturing. *Id.* at 311. Southwestern burned tires under the permit until 1993. *Id.* The County passed the lapse provision—Section 4-604 of the Code—in 1996. *Id.* In 2002, Cemex notified the County that it planned to resume tire burning. *Id.* Graham Billingsley, the County Land Use Department Director at the time, consented in a letter, stating that the lapse provision did not apply retroactively. *Id.* The Sierra

Club appealed to the County Board of Adjustment ("BOA"), which affirmed this determination. *Id.* The Sierra Club then sought review of the BOA's decision in district court, which remanded the case back to the BOA for a factual finding of whether there had been a five-year period of inactivity. *Id.* On remand, the Director found that there "had not been a complete cessation of all activity at the cement plant related to the Permit and therefore, that the permit had not lapsed." *Id.* at 311 (emphasis added). Specifically, the Director found that: (1) the facility was still in place; (2) maintenance on the site continued, as it "appear[ed] tires could be burned there at any time, and recently tires were burned for the test burn"; and (3) all of the company's state air quality permits were "active and up to date . . . as of the date of the hearing." *Id.* The BOA again affirmed the director's written determination, and Sierra Club again appealed. *Id.* The district court affirmed the BOA's decision, finding "that there had not been a continuous five-year period of inactivity under the Permit, and that the Permit was therefore still in effect." *Id.* The Sierra Club appealed the district court's decision and the Court of Appeals affirmed. *Id.* at 312-14. Although the Court of Appeals in *Billingsley* finally held on different grounds that the lapse provision did not apply,¹ the Director's findings are instructive here. Martin Marietta satisfies the same criteria the Director analyzed when concluding the permit did not lapse: (1) the "facility" is still there; (2) the "facility" has continued to be in use and able to perform the permitted activity, and (3) all related permits are up to date. *Id.* Accordingly, based on the Boulder County Land Use Director's own criteria in the Cemex case, Martin Marietta's continuous activity precluded lapsing from occurring at any point since the County granted Permit SU-96-18.

In summary, based on the continuous activity occurring on the parcels comprising Permit SU-96-18, neither lapse provision is applicable to Permit SU-96-18. Additionally, the County's prior analysis in the Cemex case further indicates that Martin Marietta's Permit has not lapsed.
