



**ADDENDUM #1  
Resource Conservation  
Non-Hazardous Liquid Disposal  
RFP # 6861-18**

July 11, 2018

The attached addendum supersedes the original Information and Specifications regarding RFP # 6861-18 where it adds to, deletes from, clarifies or otherwise modifies. All other conditions and any previous addendums shall remain unchanged.

1. Question: Will multiple liquids be mixed in the same rolloff or do you segregate the liquids by type?

**ANSWER: Multiple non-hazardous water-based liquids will be mixed in the same roll-off.**

2. Question: Will the liquids be received in closed containers such as jugs, cans, bottles?

**ANSWER: Majority of the liquids will be in closed containers. Materials are dumped into the roll-off using a 3-yard self-dumping hopper thus causing some materials to potentially leak out of the original containers.**

3. Question: What is the maximum number of rolloff boxed that will be needed at one time?

**ANSWER: Three. We will need one roll-off at all times at the Boulder County Hazardous Materials Management Facility (1901 63<sup>rd</sup> Street, Boulder) and may need up to two roll-offs during the annual Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) event on a Saturday in Longmont. This year, the event will be on Saturday, September 15, 2018.**

4. Question: What are the exact addresses of the drop-off and collection sites to be used?

**ANSWER: Boulder County Hazardous Materials Management Facility (1901 63<sup>rd</sup> Street, Boulder) and City of Longmont Public Works (375 Airport Road, Longmont)**

5. Question: Can you provide the historical number of rollofs per year for this project?

**ANSWER: Here is the historical number of rollofs per year for the last five years. Please note that the number of rollofs has decreased from prior years now that we are recycling more latex paint. Boulder County staff expects the number of roll-offs to be less than or similar to 2017 data.**

**2017 – 15 rollofs  
2016 – 23 rollofs  
2015 – 22 rollofs  
2014 – 29 rollofs  
2013 – 42 rollofs**

6. Question: In what format would you like the pricing? Per location for transportation? Per gallon or ton for disposal?

**ANSWER: Boulder County would prefer pricing by the ton or yard and a flat rate for transportation. We are willing to discuss other options if necessary.**
