When I read you each one, assume that particular ballot proposal will be the only one that appears on this November's ballot. The first is/Next: *[Randomize Q2, Q3, Q4, Q5 and Q6, but randomize Q2 & Q3 together as a pair, and Q4 & Q5 together as a pair]*

2. *[Ask Sample A]* A ballot proposal to increase the State of Colorado Sales Tax by *[Sample C read: "point zero five percent"/Sample D read: point one percent"* for the next 20 years. If passed, this ballot proposal would add *[Sample C read: "five"/Sample D read: "ten"]* cents on a one hundred dollar purchase anywhere in Colorado. The money raised by this sales tax increase will be used to pay for improvements to interstates and state highways, including improvements to I-25 and I-70, as well as highway 119, known as the Diagonal, between Boulder and Longmont, and highway 7, also known as Arapahoe Rd, between Erie, Lafayette and Boulder, as well as provide some funding for transit service between the various communities throughout Boulder County. The majority of these funds could only be used for improvements to state highways, and would be administered by the Colorado Department of Transportation, with a portion allocated to local governments for local transportation purposes. If the election were held today, would you vote in favor or against this proposal?

3. *[Ask Sample B]* A ballot proposal to increase the Boulder County Sales Tax by *[Sample E read: “point zero five percent”/Sample F read: “point one percent”* for the next 20 years. If passed, this ballot proposal would add *[Sample E read: “five”/Sample F read: “ten”]* cents on a one hundred dollar purchase made in Boulder County. The money raised by this sales and use tax would be used to improve the county transportation system, including repaving and improving the county road system, as well as contributing to state highway improvements in Boulder County, including on highway 119, known as the Diagonal, between Boulder and Longmont, and highway 7, also known as Arapahoe Rd, between Erie, Lafayette and Boulder, and providing some funding for transit service and bicycle connections between the various communities throughout Boulder County. These funds would be used primarily for the county roads, transit and bikeways, and would be administered by Boulder County. If the election were held today, would you vote in favor or against this proposal?

Now suppose there were a proposal on this November's ballot, which would increase the Boulder County Offender Management Sales Tax by point one eight five percent (.185%) for five years, beginning in two thousand twenty (2020) at which point it will expire in the year two thousand twenty-five. Revenue from this new tax will be used to fund the following: making improvements to the Boulder County jail to more safely house inmates with mental and physical health issues; increasing space for inmates participating in alternative sentencing programs like work-release; adding space to properly process inmates in and out of the facility; and adding needed administrative space. The new point one eight five percent (.185%) sales tax will replace the current Flood Sales Tax of the same value, that expires in 2020, so that the county sales tax will remain exactly the same as it is today, until the new tax expires in 2025, when it will go down. ## Methodology

2018 Boulder County June Issues Survey was conducted on behalf of Boulder County by Drake Research & Strategy, Inc., a public opinion research firm in Boulder, Colorado. The results of this survey are based upon 605 telephone interviews conducted among active voters residing in Boulder County. Drake Research purchased a sample of telephone numbers, and a supplemental list of cell phone numbers, of active County registered voters, which was then randomly sampled. Quotas were established to obtain appropriate representation for gender, geography, political party and for age. Results of the survey are also balanced by age and ethnicity to more appropriately represent the actual distribution. Interviews were conducted from April 24<sup>th</sup> to April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018. A random sample of 605 has a worst-case 95% confidence interval of plus or minus 4.0% about any one reported percentage.
