NOTE: A temporary liquor license permit may only be issued if a completed application for transfer of ownership along with all required documentation and associated fees has been submitted to the Boulder County Liquor Licensing Clerk.

A temporary liquor license permit is valid for no more than one hundred twenty days from the date of issuance and is automatically void upon completion of the transfer of ownership and issuance of a new permanent liquor license in the name of the applicant by the Colorado Department of Revenue and the Boulder County Commissioners (Local Licensing Authority).

This permit may be canceled, revoked, or summarily suspended if the Local or State Licensing Authority determines there is probable cause to believe that the transferee has violated any provision of the Colorado Liquor or Beer Code or has violated any rule or regulation adopted by the Local or State Licensing Authority or has failed to truthfully disclose those matters required pursuant to the transfer application.
