

Hello Healthy Futures Coalition members,

The following email is a little lengthy, but I'm going to attend to convey all the information I would have shared Wednesday had we met. So I recommend you find a time when you have 15-20 minutes or so to go through this "virtual meeting" and follow up on the necessary actions.

Content from HFC meeting:

- **Rise Above Colorado Presentation:** We are working to reschedule the presentation from Rise Above – hopefully we will be able to host them and hear about their youth-led prevention work soon!
- **PYD video and reflection:** Please watch this video from Donovan Livingston (5 min. 45 sec.), it's provides a great opportunity for personal reflection about how we are showing up to support and honor youth voices at HFC
- **Logic model overview:** Attached are two versions of the HFC logic model for 2018-2020. The first is a graphic representation of our logic model that we will be ordering copies of to use as a 1-pager to help orient people to the work of HFC. The second is a little less visually appealing but it has more specific information about how we will measure each action or outcome. Both of these will be available in the HFC Orientation folder in the Google Drive.
 - If you would like a more detailed overview of the HFC logic model for 2018-20, or if you are new to using logic models as a tool for planning and assessment, then you can view a recording of the logic model presentation that I was planning to share at the meeting this week.
