HOME VISITOR

Therapist and nurse trained in parent-infant relationships

GOOD MATCH

Pregnant women and parents with children ages 0-6 years old feeling overwhelmed, anxious, depressed, and/or having family conflict who would like skills for coping with emotions

DESCRIPTION

In-home visits from a psychotherapist and nurse who can help you build skills to communicate between family members; manage depression, anxiety, and past trauma; read baby's cues; parent positively; and understand healthy nutrition and feeding

Nurse specially trained in special needs

GOOD MATCH

Parents whose child was born early, has special healthcare needs, or has a traumatic brain injury

DESCRIPTION

In-home visits from a nurse who can monitor your baby's development and help you understand special health care needs and treatments, find local services, and navigate the health care system

First-time moms-to-be who have limited income who enroll any time during pregnancy and up to one month after the baby is born

In-home visits from a nurse who can monitor your child's development and help you learn skills for a healthy pregnancy and positive parenting through your child's second birthday
