
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
Boulder County Data Summary Overview

The data included in the following slides were selected through a narrowing process of over 500 County-level behavioral health indicators from publicly available data descriptors and assessments to provide a **high-level summary of substance use and mental health issues for people of different ages and stages** in Boulder County.

PLEASE NOTE: In areas where similar data were available for the state of Colorado, comparisons have been made as **general observations only and statistically significant differences should not be inferred.**



Substance Use: Pregnancy


Pregnancy & Neonatal



The percentage of women who use alcohol during pregnancy in Boulder County is greater than in the state of Colorado. The percentage of women who use tobacco during pregnancy is lower.

Pre- and Post-Partum Mental Health

Pregnancy & Neonatal



A majority of mothers in Boulder County report that they are informed about post-partum depression and about what they should do if they become depressed during or after pregnancy.




The percentage of children exposed to secondhand smoke is lower for children in Boulder County than in Colorado.



Mental Health and Behavioral Problems

Early Childhood: Ages 1 - 14



Boulder County parents report similar experiences with emotional, developmental, and behavioral issues with children compared to Colorado.



The rate of child abuse is lower in Boulder County than the state of Colorado. Of cases of child abuse in Boulder County in 2017-18, about half of the households were located in Longmont.





The percentage of children reporting bullying in Boulder County is similar to Colorado. A smaller percentage of 7th and 8th graders in BVSD have attempted suicide compared to Colorado.



Think it's easy to obtain alcohol


High school students in Boulder Valley School District perceive that it is easier to obtain alcohol than high school students in Colorado.

Boulder Valley School District high school students perceive that it is easier to obtain marijuana and electronic nicotine products than high school students in Colorado, and are more likely to use those substances.



Boulder County's adult binge drinking rate meets the Healthy People 2020 target for binge drinking.

The opioid prescription fill rate is lower in Boulder County than in Colorado.




The rate of law enforcement charges for possession of heroin is higher than the rate for opioids in Boulder County.

Mental Health Adults

Percentage of adults who experienced 8 or more days in poor mental health in past month



Needed mental health care/counseling but did not get it



Suicide Rate

Healthy People 2020 target **10.2/100,000**

Adults in Boulder County report fewer days in poor mental health than adults in Colorado. There are still adults who report needing mental health care but who did not receive it.

of Boulder County jail population has been identified as needing assessment for mental health issues.




of people who leave the jail are connected to substance use disorder treatment. All people who enter the jail system are identified as needing assessment for substance use disorder.


Behavioral Health Needs for Older Adults

Adults Age 65+

Older adults who rate overall mental health/emotional wellbeing as "excellent" or "good"



Percentage of adults 65+ who reported binge drinking at least once during the last 30 days



The majority of adults 65 and older in Boulder County report their mental health and emotional well being as good or excellent. This rate is similar to the rate in Colorado.
