District Attorney Michael Dougherty and Colorado Attorney General Phil Weiser to Host Town Hall in Longmont

On March 11, 2020, District Attorney Michael Dougherty and Attorney General Phil Weiser will host a town hall discussion on criminal justice reform from 4:00 pm to 5:00 pm at the Longmont Museum at 400 Quail Road in Longmont. The event is free, and the public is welcome to attend.

District Attorney Dougherty is committed to enhancing public safety and improving the justice system. He has long been an advocate and leader in criminal justice reform efforts. Since he took office in 2018, the District Attorney's Office has significantly expanded our Restorative Justice & Diversion Program, launched the first pre-charging Mental Health Diversion Program in the state, established the first Fresh Start Warrant Program for low-level offenders in the State of Colorado, and implemented innovative programs to fight hate crimes, wage theft, and sex offenses. Attorney General Phil Weiser has been a strong working partner in criminal justice and reform efforts.

On March 11th, District Attorney Dougherty and Attorney General Weiser will have brief opening remarks and then will open the event to questions from the community. They look forward to talking about the important work being done in Boulder and around Colorado to improve our criminal justice system and enhance public safety.
