



Proof of Tax Paid

Out of State Purchase

For proof of tax paid on an out of state purchase, supply one of the following:

- 1. A statement from the dealer where you purchased the vehicle, which must be on dealer letterhead and contain the following information:**
 - a. Purchase price
 - b. Tax amount collected by the dealership and what state it was remitted to
 - c. Year, make, and VIN of the vehicle
 - d. Owner(s) name and legal (physical) address
 - e. Must be signed by the agent and notarized or signed under penalty of perjury**
- 2. Letter from the state the vehicle was purchased from stating sales tax was paid, including the following information:**
 - a. Purchase price
 - b. Tax amount collected
 - c. Year, make & VIN of the vehicle
 - d. Owner(s) name and legal (physical) address
 - e. Must be notarized or signed under penalty of perjury**
- 3. State-issued receipt showing the amount of sales tax collected for the purchase of the vehicle, including the following information:**
 - a. Purchase price
 - b. Tax amount collected
 - c. Year, make & VIN of the vehicle
 - d. Owner(s) name and legal (physical) address

Example of Penalty of Perjury Statement:

“I certify under penalty of perjury in the 2nd degree that the above statements are true and correct.”

Lease Buyout

For proof of tax paid on a lease buyout, supply the following:

1. Purchase price
2. Tax amount collected, if applicable
3. Year, make & VIN of the vehicle
4. Owner(s) name
5. Additional information from lease company:
 - a. Colorado form DR 00024 (**Sales Tax Receipt**) correctly filled out, or
 - b. Bill of sale or purchase order showing the purchase price and any tax collected by the lessor
