

RESOLUTION 2020-06

A RESOLUTION SUMMARIZING EXPENDITURES AND REVENUES FOR EACH FUND AND ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR BOULDER COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH, BOULDER, COLORADO, FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR BEGINNING ON THE FIRST DAY OF JANUARY 2021 AND ENDING ON THE LAST DAY OF DECEMBER 2021.

WHEREAS, the Boulder County Board of Health has appointed Director of Administration and Finance Services Megan Hatten to prepare and submit a current operating budget to said governing body at the proper time summarizing any changes; and

WHEREAS, the Boulder County Board of Health adopted Resolution 2020-03 on September 14, 2020, which approved and adopted a budget for Boulder County Public Health for calendar year 2021 in the amount of \$18,249,432; and

WHEREAS, whatever increases may have been made in the expenditures, like increases were added to the revenues so that the budget is in balance, as required by law.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Boulder County Board of Health of Boulder County Public Health, Boulder, Colorado:

Section 1. That estimated expenditures for 2021 are as follows:
