Pandemic Workforce Equipment Support (PWES) Program

To support employees through their work during the pandemic, leadership approved a program to supply any employees with equipment to continue their work in these unprecedented situations. After taking whatever was useful from office sites, employees could then choose from pre-approved categories of items to order for their remote or field work.

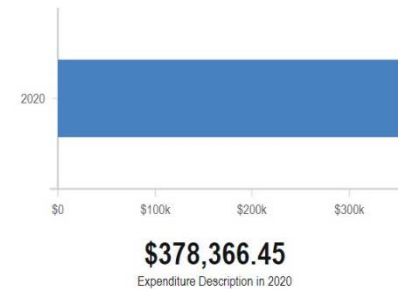
Orders included (but were not limited to):

- 172 desk chairs
- 140 webcams
- 24 monitors
- 195 headsets

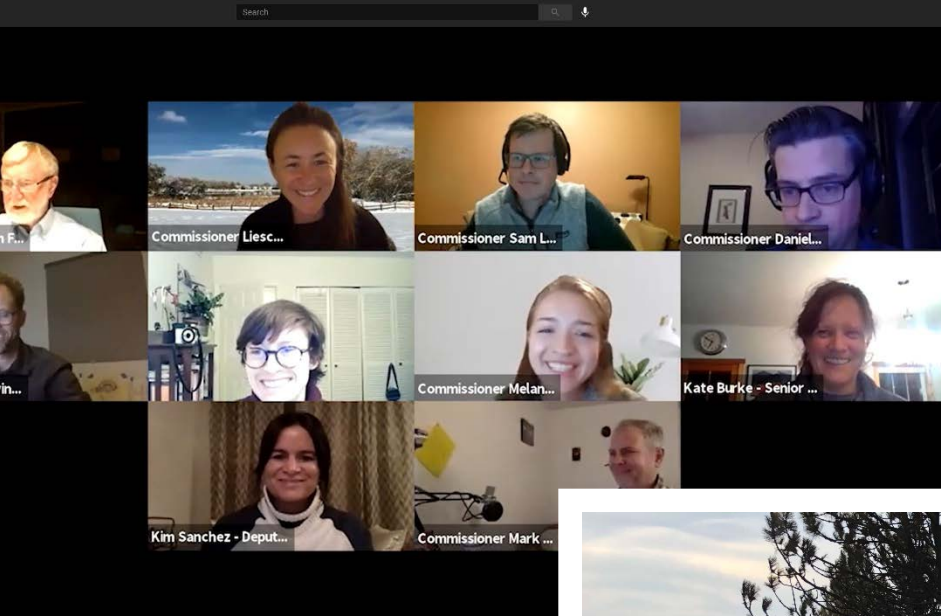
Orders were made from 16 of our 19 departments and offices, and were distributed to more than 600 employees. This program was designed to provide employees with any reasonable and necessary equipment to complete their job duties.

Over the course of three days, the Forward Together Safely team was able to safely distribute ordered items to those nearly 600 employees along with sets of face masks for each employee. We now expect employees to have a more efficient and comfortable remote or field work experience into the future.

The Boulder District Attorney's Office is offering a **VIRTUAL 3-day (20 hours)** Restorative Justice (RJ) Facilitator training.

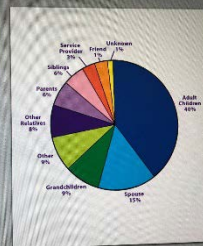
You will learn:

Board of Equalization (BOE)

2020 Deadline to Appeal the Board of Equalization is Sept. 28

Property owners who disagree with the Assessor's Notice of Determination can appeal that decision to the Board of Equalization (BOE). The deadline to petition the BOE is Sept. 23 unless the 2020 falls on a weekend or holiday; then the deadline will fall on the following business day. As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, an Executive Order of the Governor, D.2020.022 has extended the deadline to Sept. 28, 2020.

Important information for petitioners:

All 2020 Board of Equalization hearings will be held remotely to ensure the safety of the public and staff.

When filing an appeal, any evidence previously submitted to the Assessor during your initial protest, which you wish to have considered at your hearing, must be resubmitted to the Board of Equalization. Submit all documents in duplicate, including any you may bring directly to the hearing. The Board of Equalization is not affiliated with the Assessor's Office. All documents submitted become part of the record and cannot be returned.

All petitioners can request data supporting the Assessor's valuation from the Assessor's office. Within three working days of the receipt of your written request, the data supporting the Assessor's valuation shall be available to you at the Assessor's Office, 3325 Pearl Street. For more information, call the Assessor's Office at 303-443-3530.

Due to COVID-19, appealing online is highly encouraged. When you appeal online, you also have the option to schedule your hearing, otherwise a hearing date will be scheduled for you. Due to COVID-19, your hearing may be
