FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATION FACT SHEET

JANUARY 15, 2021

Today, January 15, 2021, President Donald J. Trump granted a Major Disaster Declaration for the State of Colorado triggering the release of Federal funds to help communities recover from wildfires that occurred September 6 - November 5, 2020. Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows:
