Press Release – King Soopers Shooting – Additional Charges Filed

Based on developments in the ongoing investigation, the District Attorney's Office has determined that additional crimes and sentence enhancers must be charged in this matter. Therefore, the District Attorney's Office has filed a motion to amend the Complaint and Information, specifically by amending certain counts and adding several additional counts of Attempted Murder. The additional charges pertain to eight (8) civilian victims located in King Soopers on March 22, 2021 for whom Attempted Murder counts are being added. These victims are now listed in the amended Complaint and Information. With these additions, the allegations now include a total of ten (10) murder victims, fifteen (15) civilian victims of Attempted Murder, and eleven (11) victims of Attempted Murder who are members of law enforcement.

The suspect in the King Soopers shooting is set for a Status Hearing on Tuesday, May 25, 2021 at 8:15 am in Chief Judge Ingrid Bakke's courtroom, Courtroom G, Division 13. Those who wish to attend virtually can do so here:

A Status Hearing is a hearing set by the Court to determine the next steps in the case, to include addressing any issues the parties need to raise with the judge. Future hearing dates will also be discussed and scheduled at the Status Hearing.

As in every criminal case, the charges are merely an accusation and the defendant is presumed innocent until or unless proven guilty.
