1. Question: Could you supply detailed pictures of a Current car setup like this so we can see how things are mounted.

ANSWER: Included. Please see link above.

2. Question: The 3" Mpowers where are they installed? In the Grille? In the for Ford Factory Location?

ANSWER: They are installed in the Ford factory location in the grill.

3. Question: The two momentary Buttons, what are the functions tied to those buttons and where are they installed in the car?

ANSWER: One of the buttons is to reset the system and is located on the right-side front of the center console. The second was used to turn off the rear interior traffic advisor, which will not be a part of future patrol builds.

4. Question: Where does the LED Red Mini marker light get installed and what is it's function and how is it activated?

ANSWER: The marker light is located on the passenger side roof for the prisoner containment system. It is activated by a switch on the emergency light control panel.

5. Question: Are you running a single radio or dual radios or one Dual Band radio? (what Brand and Model Radio).

ANSWER: Our current radio is a Motorola APX8500 All Band. SKU: M37TSS9PW1_N.

6. Question: Are you running a camera system in the vehicle and if so which system?

ANSWER: Not currently. However, this will change in the future.

7. Question: Is the Dome light in the Front between the driver's seat or in the rear cargo area?

ANSWER: This is in both areas. One between driver and passenger front and in the cargo area mounted to the lift gate.

8. Question: In regard to the Setina Storage Vault there are several options on how that is configured and which lock, which sections have locks, is the top a locking tray or an open tray?

ANSWER: Our set up would be TK0252ITU20 and TPA9289 accessory radio tray.

9. Question: Are the vehicles included as part of this bid or only the lighting and equipment? We have the capability of supplying the units as well.

ANSWER: We will continue to procure the vehicles and will only be needing the lighting and equipment. We will often supply items that are reusable from vehicles leaving service or are procured through other channels such as our radios to save costs.

10. Question: On page 8 of the bid (page 9 of the .pdf document) you have part number 99-013-004 from Setina listed. Per Lisa Cobb at Setina: Setina does not

have any part with that number. Can you clarify what you want, and/or supply photos of what you want for this line?

ANSWER: TK0252ITU20 and TPA9289 accessory radio tray.

11. Question: Page 6 / "Scope Of Work" / # 2 - Installer must install ... Motorola Radio... & CradlePoint system o Will the county be supplying these items or are you seeking "new parts" also as part of the bid submission? ▪ What Model and Spec. for each of these 2 items is desired (if new from bidder)

ANSWER: The radio and CradlePoint modem and antenna are currently supplied by Boulder County and will not be a part of the bid submission.

12. Question: Page 7 / "Equipment Section" / 1st Paragraph - You note, in part, "do not include installation or accessories charge" o But on Page 9 (end of the equipment list) you specifically list "MISC" and "LABOR" as the last 2 items ▪ Do you want misc. shop supplies and labor included on the Bid Submission or not?

ANSWER: These should be considered MISC as the wiring harness needed for the up-fit. Labor refers to the hourly labor rate that is charged by vendor. We understand that the list of parts given to work with may not constitute a complete turn-key vehicle and likely would need additional items. This list represents more of the major components that we currently use and is designed to help us understand bid pricing comparisons more clearly.

13. Question: Page 9 / "Equipment" / 7300-0160 Antenna - You note a 7300-0160 GPSS Dual Pass Through – TN Antenna o This is used to go directly to a docking station (no modem) ▪ But you note earlier on the RFP that there is a CradlePoint Modem Is this the correct item you want pricing on? If not – what is the correct P/N that you desire pricing on? Presumably to connect directly to your modem.

ANSWER: For the purpose of this bid 7300-0160 as the antenna being installed. In practice and future builds Boulder County intends to supply the appropriate antenna for the CradlePoint system.

14. Question: Pages 8 & 9 / "Equipment"- Will the county be supplying a wire harness (I don't see anything noted/listed on the spec to otherwise account for this) or are you wanting a wire harness as part of the bid spec / pricing?

ANSWER: Yes, the wire harness should be a part of the bid submission in the area of MISC. We understand that this is a large and expensive piece of the up-fit and will expect high quality components and techniques to be used in the procurement of or manufacture of the harness.

In practice we will request wiring diagrams to be provided for each vehicle built. We will also request that we have access to the software for programming and repair of the controller, such as SoundOff BluePrint, Whelen CenCom, etc.
