Visitation Spotlight

2,135,586 minimum estimated visits in 2020

Visitation was estimated at 24 properties and 5 regional trails.

The minimum estimated number of visits to Boulder County Parks and Open Space (BCPOS) parks in 2020 was 2,135,586. This was an increase of 45% from the previous year's visitation number of 1,470,032 visits.

This year emphasized the important physical, social, and emotional benefits provided by nature. Even as the COVID-19 pandemic placed restrictions on public activities and gatherings starting in March, parks and trails remained open as an essential service. Coloradoans were encouraged to stay at home and enjoy the vast, great outdoors. Park visitation increased significantly, and trails remained consistently busier each month through the rest of the year.

This fall, Boulder County was in a severe drought with dry and warm weather. On a windy Saturday in October, the Cal-Wood fire broke out and spread quickly east, requiring the evacuation and closure of Heil Valley Ranch and other nearby open spaces. A large portion of Heil Valley Ranch was burned, and the main trailhead had significant damage. The southern portion of Heil Valley Ranch remained closed through the end of the year as restoration efforts were planned.







Methodology

Education & Outreach and Resource Protection staff are assigned property-specific data-collection duties. At the beginning of every month, staff download data from each counter. Counter data is uploaded to TRAFx DataNet, a web-based system to view and analyze the count data. Each month, the following adjustments are applied:

 $\{(Counter data) \times (Average # visitors per vehicle at park)\} = Total for that month$

Counter data is divided by two for any trails and parking lots where visitors enter and exit from the same access point. For parking lots with one-way entrances, the counter's number is not divided by two. For vehicle counters, the data is multiplied by the average number of visitors per vehicle. That adjustment is calculated for each property using the 2015 BCPOS Five Year Study visitor survey. For trail counters, the average number of visitors per vehicle in that park is not applied.

Data from 2019 was used in instances when a trail or vehicle counter was malfunctioning for a month or longer. When a counter was malfunctioning for a shorter period of time, an average daily traffic adjustment for that month was used for individual days.

After the adjustments are completed, each month's data is assigned to the appropriate season, which is calculated as follows:

Winter = January, February and December

Spring = March, April and May

Summer = June, July and August

Fall = September, October and November

These calculations give us a minimum estimated number of visits to parks with active counters. Please note that "number of visits" is not equal to "number of visitors." That is, the same visitor may visit the same park many times during one year.

Parks fall into three categories for visitor use:

Low use < 50,000 visits per year

Medium use 50,000 - 100,000 visits per year

High use > 100,000 visits per year

Since 11 public parks and neighborhood trails do not have counters, their visitation must be estimated. The annual estimates provided by observational studies at Twin Lakes (103,139 visits) and the Coal Creek, Rock Creek, and LOBO trails (268,000 total visits) have been adjusted to reflect the overall percent change in visitation estimated by properties with counters and included in the overall minimum estimated number of visits. Visitation at the Beech property is calculated using picnic shelter reservations, since the trails are managed by the City of Boulder.

For the properties where observational data has not been collected, estimates are based on averages from properties with similar visitation that do have counters. Using data from those counters, we estimate the average visitation for other parks in that visitor-use category and apply that average to each of the parks in categories that do not have counters.

Properties with Counters Notes

All trail and vehicle counters are Trafx counters that record timestamped hourly data for visitation. These counters make it possible to monitor hourly, daily, weekly, and monthly visitation at properties to identify trends.

Much of the increase in visitation can be attributed to the COVID-19 pandemic restricting many activities, while encouraging more outdoor recreation. In 2020, Boulder County weather was overall warmer and dryer than average. The winter and spring months started the year with good moisture, with February being especially snowy. Hall Ranch, Heil Valley Ranch, and Ron Stewart Preserve at Rabbit Mountain experienced intermittent muddy trail closures from January to April. The summer months were hot and dry, so that by the time fall approached, drought conditions across the state had worsened.

The three largest wildfires in state history happened in 2020, along with many other smaller wildfires occurring simultaneously, including the Cal-Wood and Lefhand Canyon fires in Boulder County. With wildfires across the state, the air quality was intermittently very poor during the months of August, September, and October. In October, the Cal-Wood fire burned a large portion of Heil Valley Ranch. The Picture Rock Trailhead reopened December 4. The Main Trailhead and Corral Trailhead were closed through to the end of the year because of hazardous conditions.

As a result of extreme fire conditions, many Boulder County Parks and Open Space properties were closed Oct. 21 to Nov. 9, in accord with the U.S. Forest Service closure of the Arapahoe and Roosevelt National Forests. The properties closed included: Anne U. White, Bald Mountain, Caribou Ranch, Hall Ranch, Hessie Trailhead, and Mud Lake. Additionally, Rocky Mountain National Park was closed because of the East Troublesome fire from Oct. 22 to Nov. 6. In November and December, when parks were open again and there were increased public restrictions because of the COVID-19 infection rate, we saw a large increase in visitation at parks compared to 2019. The weather was also dry and relatively warm for the time of year.

Additional notes:

- The Boulder Canyon Project continued this year, and the Boulder Canyon Trail was closed because of construction.
- The number of people-per-vehicle adjustment for Pella Crossing uses 2010 Five Year Study data, since the property was closed during the 2015 survey.
- Caribou Ranch has an annual closure from April 1 through June 30, which is reflected in the low number of estimated visits for the spring season.
- Ron Stewart Preserve at Rabbit Mountain was closed Monday to Wednesday, Jan. 1 to 29, and Sept. 21 to Dec 31 (except for certain holidays) for elk management. If the hunters were successful, the park was opened for the week.
- At Walden Ponds Wildlife Habitat many vehicles drive through both parking lots during a trip to the property, passing through the lot at Wally Toevs Pond on the way to park at the Cottonwood Trailhead.

More detailed information about specific properties can be found in individual property reports.

Parks Visitation

The estimates provided here are minimum estimates. Visitation numbers may be higher, but they are probably not any lower. Some parks have separate access points without counters, or they receive visitors who are biking, running, riding or walking, rather than driving a vehicle into a park with a vehicle counter. Additionally, vehicle counters are calibrated to estimate visits from people arriving in cars, SUVs and small trucks, not longer vehicles like school or tour buses. The properties are listed based on the estimated number of visits from the highest to the lowest in 2020.





Properties without counters account for 32% of the overall estimated visitation. Between July and September of 2012, an observational spot study was completed at Twin Lakes to estimate annual visitation. Furthermore, the annual visitation at three regional trails was estimated by a 2013 small grant study conducted by Schulte and Flohr. The annual estimates provided by these studies for Twin Lakes (103,139 visits) and the Coal Creek, Rock Creek, and LOBO trails (268,000 total visits) have been adjusted to reflect the average percent change in visitation at properties with counters in the years since the research was conducted. We plan to conduct new observational studies of visitation to update the regional trails estimates in 2022. Visitation at the Beech property is calculated using picnic shelter reservations since the trails are managed by the City of Boulder.

For the properties where observational or counter data has not been collected, estimates are based on averages from properties with similar visitation that do have counters. Each of the three "use" categories has at least four properties with a counter. Using data from those counters, we can then estimate the average visitation for the other parks in that category. We then apply that average to each of the parks in categories that do not have counters.

Park Visitor Activities

Paid staff and Volunteer Ranger Corps (VRC) volunteers observed 71,651 visitors on BCPOS lands that were open to the public. This table summarizes park visitors' activities at those areas. In 2020, more time was spent at trailheads and on trails closer to the trailhead than in previous years to assist with parking and encourage social distancing.










Visitation by Location






Average Visitation by Hour






Visitation by Month




Visitation by Location








Visitation by Location






Average Daily Visitation Jan. 30 - Sept. 20




Average Daily Visitation Sept. 21 - Dec. 31






Visitation by Location


