

OWTS materials unavailable due to COVID-19 Pandemic

This policy is intended to address OWTS material shortages due to COVID-19 pandemic.

- If a partial final is needed to backfill while waiting for components to be in-stock BCPH will waive additional inspection fees.
- If an engineer design specifies chambers for the distribution media but these are unavailable, please contact the engineer to receive approval to use a different media (i.e. rock and pipe). This should be addressed in the final approval letter completed by the engineer.
- If panel, pump or other specified component is not available please contact the engineer to find an alternate solution. If it is not specified in the design please contact the engineer for approval to use a substitute component. This should be addressed in the final approval letter completed by the engineer.
- BCPH will waive fees for partial inspections due to supply unavailability.
- BCPH reserves the right to ask for documentation of supply limitations.
