Boulder County Legal Services

- Provides legal assistance in limited civil matters to low-income Boulder County residents who meet income guidelines, and to adults age 60 and over regardless of income who meet eligibility guidelines.

Bridge to Justice

- Assists individuals who do not qualify for free legal services through Boulder County Legal Services or other legal aid providers but who cannot afford a private attorney.
- Provides services to those who qualify based on HUD income guidelines.

- Offers mediation services to individuals living in Boulder County outside Boulder or Longmont.
- Assists with issues including neighbors, roommates, HOAs, easements, pets, noise, etc.
- Does not mediate family law or landlord-tenant issues.
