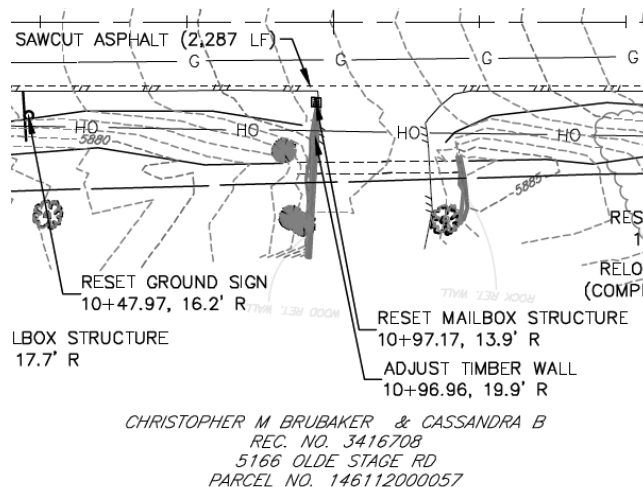
1. Question: Are there CAD files available? If not, are we able to get a tabulation of earthwork quantities please?

**ANSWER: 351 CY of Cut (mostly for area to add ABC under paved shoulder)
56 CY of Fill (for tie in embankment).
Results in 295 CY of excess soil for removal (or can be used in general mill/overlay areas as needed).**

2. Question: Can you provide more details on the reset timber wall at Station 10+96.96.



ANSWER: Roughly a 6 foot section of this wall will need to be removed. The shoulder widening will fill in this area and there is no need for a wall for the 6 feet. Beyond that, the wall can remain but we will need to saw cut at that point. The timbers don't align vertically so can't just remove first section of timbers. Coordination with the property owner will be needed.



3. Question: On the Clear n Grub Special bit item, why is it called “Special”, and what does it all include?

ANSWER: This work consists of clearing, grubbing, removing, and disposing of vegetation and debris within the limits of the right of way, easement areas, borrow pits, and other areas shown in the Contract or required by the work. Including tree trimming and road shoulders. Vegetation and objects designated to remain shall be preserved free from injury or defacement.

4. Question: On all of the asphalt bid items it ends with “Special” at the end of each description. What is included in the term special?

ANSWER: All bid items with “(Special)” added means the contractor should refer to that item in the Project Special Provisions.

5. Question: For the widening of the shoulders from station 10+50 to 12+00, how realistic is building this without filling the ditch completely first and cutting it back out? Please refer to the cross sections on plan sheet 34.

ANSWER: Construction Plans show this information in plan view, typical section, and cross section. There may need to be some equipment access outside the shown limits of disturbance but there is adequate room within the existing ROW to complete the work.

6. Question: What is the purpose of the item “Removal of Pipe (Misc)” and the 18” Steel Pipe (Misc)? Are there specific locations where this work will be performed? It’s difficult to bid this without knowing where the work is located, what utilities may be encountered and what depth is required.

ANSWER: These items are to cover remove/replace driveway culverts as needed along the mill/overlay portion of project. These culverts are typically directly under the driveway and no utility conflicts. An assumed quantity of 250 LF was provided for bidding purposes but actual work to be determined by the Project Engineer during construction.

7. Question: What is the anticipated Notice to Proceed date?

ANSWER: Approximately 8-12 weeks from bid opening.

8. Question: Will the County be responsible for all materials testing?

ANSWER: Boulder County will provide a qualified Construction Quality Assurance team to perform Quality Assurance (QA) auditing and acceptance testing. The QA staff shall remain independent from the Contractor’s production and Quality Control (QC)... The Boulder County construction QA Team or Consultant’s will perform on-site inspection and testing of the construction elements of the work to verify that all work has been constructed in conformance with the Contract requirements.

The Contractor shall be responsible to establish, document, and implement a Quality Control Plan. The Quality Control Plan shall include all procedures necessary for the Contractor to control the quality of its production processes to meet the requirements of the Contract. The Contractor’s Quality Control Plan shall include a testing and inspection schedule to control the production processes.

9. Question: Does the County know of any land available on the project that could be used for a staging area?

ANSWER: No specific staging area has been called out.
