Benefit	Eligibility	Information
EcoPass	Benefitted employees	All benefitted employees are given an EcoPass at the start of employment. EcoPasses can be used anytime for unlimited rides on all RTD buses and trains including the bus or train to Denver International Airport and Fort Collins (using the FLEX bus). This form is for replacement passes due to loss or name change or if they did not receive a pass when benefitted employment started.
Transit Voucher	Non-benefitted, volunteers, senior tax workers	Transit vouchers pay approximately 100% of the cost of commuting to and from work on RTD buses and trains. Individual can fill out <a href="this form">this form</a> to receive vouchers.
Guaranteed Ride Home Click on link for program details	All: Benefitted employees Non-benefitted, volunteers and senior tax workers who have who commuted to work by transit, vanpool, biking, or walking	Guaranteed Ride Home by anyone who commuted to work by transit, vanpool, biking, or walking to get home in case of an emergency. Guaranteed Ride Home pays the total cost of a taxi ride home. A maximum of 100 miles per trip is allowed. Intermediate stops, such picking up kids at day care or to a doctor are allowed if they relate to your emergency. Criteria for using Guaranteed Ride Home  If employee become ill and need to leave work If a family member becomes ill  If a child-related emergency occurs Rare unanticipated, unexpected, unscheduled overtime that requires employee to miss the carpool or vanpool ride leaving work or work beyond scheduled bus or rail service
<b>BCycle</b> Bike Share	Everyone with a current Boulder County email	Register for a free annual membership at <a href="https://boulder.bcycle.com/county">https://boulder.bcycle.com/county</a> Bcycle is currently only operating in the City of Boulder. (Credit card info is collected during membership sign up for rides that are longer than 60 minutes)
Vanpool	Benefitted and non-benefitted and volunteers, senior tax workers.	Vanpools are available for three or more people that share a commute. Most of the cost of the vanpool is paid for by the County. Each vanpool participant pays a small monthly payroll deduction based on miles traveled, usually between \$15- \$25/mth
