## 4. DRCOG TIP: FY 22-25 MM/AQ

### a. Call 1 Update- DRCOG Board to approve funding on 5/18

Projects won't be put into TIP until September.

### b. Call 2

- Call 2 is now open. As a reminder, all agencies are eligible to submit applications (regardless of whether or not they submitted a 1-pager abstract)
- Boulder County Forum approved changes to application weighting, scoring methodology
- Each jurisdiction will need to identify 1 staff member who will score all Call 2 applications, except their own agency's; confirming we are also requesting 1 DRCOG staff member to score all applications
- Deadlines- see email from Todd Cottrell that Alex HW forwarded... first deadline for support forms is May 13.

Yes, we do want to request 1 DRCOG staff member to join the scoring panel

- Please decide who will score applications by our June Forum TAC meeting

Only one representative from each jurisdiction.

Only need to seek concurrence from CDOT if project is on a CDOT facility or on CDOT ROW and only need concurrence from RTD if project is requesting more service or impacts a transit stop or other RTD facility.
