
CO119 Corridor Improvements in Boulder & Longmont -Informational Item

- CO119 corridor improvements in Boulder & Longmont
- City of Boulder:
 - Intersection improvements:
 - 28th Street and Canyon Boulevard,
 - 28th and Iris Avenue, and
 - Foothills/Diagonal plus
 - Eastbound BAT lane and enhanced transit stop at Diagonal/Foothills
 - Bike path connections to the commuter bikeway.
- City of Longmont:
 - BAT lanes along CO119
 - Bus priority signalization and intersection safety improvements, plus
 - Pedestrian and bicycle improvements
- Total project budget: \$15M
 - DRCOG Regional request: \$12M (~80%)
 - Local match: \$3M (~20%)
 - City of Longmont: \$2M
 - City of Boulder: \$1M


