## Call 2 Scoring Procedures:

# TAC Recommendation to remove scoring bias

- 1. Staff representative from each jurisdiction scores all Call 2 project applications, except their own agencies
- 2. All project scores from all scorers are averaged
- 3. Each scorer's scores are averaged
- 4. Each scorer's project score is multiplied by (all scorer's avg / that individual scorer's avg)
- 5. The resulting scores from each scorer from each project are averaged, along with any DRCOG staff scores
  - DRCOG staff scores can be used as-is since they will score every project

# Why is this important?

- If someone is a very generous scorer, all projects benefit from their generosity except their own agency's projects
  - (this unfairly penalizes projects submitted by this scorer's agency)
- If someone is a very harsh strict scorer, all projects receive a strict score except their own agency's projects
  - (this unfairly advantages projects submitted by this scorer's agency)

# What do staff need to do differently when scoring projects?

- Nothing
- Staff scoring projects just need to score all projects as fairly and objectively as possible

    - Would the Forum prefer to meet once for review of the TAC recommendations and a second time to vote on the proposed list of projects? Or combine into one meeting? Forum funding recommendations for Call #4 are due to DRCOG by March 15<sup>th</sup>.
  - April through December 2023
    - Proposing scheduling regularly occurring Forum meetings every other month or quarterly, and continue TAC meetings monthly
