Casa de la Esperanza was able to continue offering a hybrid model for programming with most of them being virtual and a few in person sessions. Around 65 youth participated in these programs, with some of the youngest being only 3 years old. Parents would also join our sessions to help their children during the activities. We were able to achieve all of this thanks to our 15 volunteers completing 272 hours for a total value of \$7,072.

FOOD & OTHER SERVICES



COMMUNITY FOOD SHARE

Our food distribution program through Community Food Share was able to provide food boxes two times a month to 45 families. The food boxes contained canned fruits and vegetables, fresh produce, potatoes, rice, meat, fruit and vegetables, and two gallons of milk. In 2021, our program helped distribute 87,617lbs of food, an average of more than 1,900lbs per family.

BRIDGE HOUSE

Families also received 1,440 mission meals which equals to 5,760 individual meals. Mission meals were provided by Community Table Kitchen through Bridge House in Boulder.



SUCCESS OVER THE YEARS

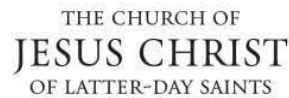
Our program has helped youth graduate high school and seek higher education. Currently, we hold a 100% graduation rate since 2009. In 2021, our program had 6 youth graduate from high school.

SPECIAL EVENTS

The families participated in special events such as Valentines Day, Halloween, Day of the Dead, and Christmas. We distributed gifts to 80 children and grocery gift cards to 45 families. Additionally, Santa made a visit and families took pictures with him.
