Survey is Anonymous and Voluntary







- BVSD middle (N=127 students) and high schools (N=1749 students)

Correlation does not equal causation


Ice Cream Sales vs. Shark Attacks





Confidence intervals help identify statistically significant differences


- Tell us how precise data is

- Are included in bar graphs
























Reported increased daily stress due to COVID19
