ORC Ops Report

- 42 Barber Ln had a grinder pump alarm go off that was silenced, resulting in a back-up in the house. Homeowner requested some warning for alarms in the future. Committee and county to work on an afterhours notification system.
- ORC to provide grinder pump replacement list.

Invoices and Budget

- Concerns about the three “bad addresses” for utility locates
- ORC to include addresses for grinder pump items on invoice
- No issues with other invoices.

New/Old Business

- Taylor to get invoices, minutes, and other reports to committee days in advance.
- The committee would like a contact list to be made for the community
- Flyers being sent out for Xpress Bill Pay and WWTF use, also to be posted at post office. Work to notify both landlords and tenants.
- Wright Water Engineers gave a proposal for methanol approval including 5 task to be performed and an hourly cost, not to exceed \$10,000 for the whole project. The committee discussed the proposal, as well as compliance issues related to the use of methanol
- Gabby explained to the committee how the state handles violations with a “point-system” similar to points on a drivers license
- The EASi Pool and Ballroom is connected to the system but is currently completely dry and not in use yet. The state has approved the lift stations and once the flow meters are calibrated the stations will be allowed to run. We clarified that pool water will not be flowing through these stations and that they are used for wastewater and backwash.
- ORC to provide flowmeter data in monthly ops report.
- Jennifer and Taylor working to apply for a grant with the states revolving fund. Future projects still include a back-up generator, a digester tank, davit crane, and more grinder pumps.

Comments Open for 2025 LID Transfer

Still waiting on county leadership for more information. Committee reaffirms desire for transparency as information becomes available.
