

## ADDENDUM #1 Housing and Human Services Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Outreach RFP # 7503-23

August 28, 2023

The attached addendum supersedes the original Information and Specifications regarding RFP # 7503-23 where it adds to, deletes from, clarifies or otherwise modifies. All other conditions and any previous addendums shall remain unchanged.

- 1. Question: How is the target increase of 3,850 enrollments per year being measured? Specifically:
  - a. If this is an increase over a current baseline, what is that baseline?
  - b. How will an awarded organization be measured (i.e., what is the methodology for assessing success)?
  - c. Will the 3,850 increase be applied to both years? For example, will the Year 1 goal be baseline + 3,850 and Year 2 goal be baseline + 7,700? Or will the goal for both years be baseline + 3,850?

## Answer:

- a. If this is an increase over a current baseline, what is that baseline?
  - i. We are using the Case, client and issuance reports (FNS-388)

  - ii. We will be measuring based on the caseload by county CY2023 report.
  - iii. As of July, 2023 Boulder County has 17,994 individuals on SNAP.
  - iv. Year 1: 21,844 individuals enrolled
  - v. Year 2 goal: 25,694 individuals enrolled

- b. How will an awarded organization be measured (i.e., what is the methodology for assessing success)?
  - i. We will require a monthly template to be submitted by the organization indicating the number of new applications submitted and the county will conduct data matching to determine if those applications resulted in enrollments and the outcome of the eligibility determination (approved or denied).
  - ii. We will also expect narrative information about progress for the month including:
    - Initial analysis of qualitative and quantitative information and data around 1) general barriers to SNAP enrollment/recertification, 2) barriers to identifying and/or connecting with all potential Eligible But Not Enrolled (EBNE), 3) disparities in access to or participation in SNAP enrollment processes and/or SNAP utilization for BIPOC communities, and 4) unique characteristics or circumstances related to Boulder County residents or communities that may contribute to lower SNAP enrollment rates compared to neighboring large counties.
- c. Will the 3,850 increase be applied to both years? For example, will the Year 1 goal be baseline + 3,850 and Year 2 goal be baseline + 7,700? Or will the goal for both years be baseline + 3,850?
  - i. Correct, after year two we will expect baseline + 7,700. See section a for goals
