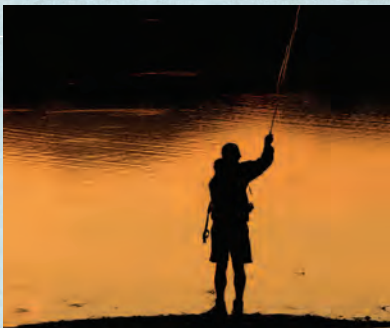

## FISHING REGULATIONS



- Angler platforms are available at Wally Toevs Pond and Duck Pond.
- Except for Wally Toevs Pond, only artificial flies or lures allowed.
- All smallmouth and largemouth bass caught must be returned to the water immediately.
- Fishing not allowed on Cottonwood Marsh.
- A Colorado fishing license is required for anglers 16 years and older.
- All State of Colorado fishing regulations apply.
- Wally Toevs Pond offers fishing for seniors and people with disabilities and their companions 15 years and younger. The fishing pier is accessible.
