**Press Release – King Soopers Shooting –  
Hearing Set for November 14, 2023**

The defendant in the King Soopers shooting is set for a Preliminary Hearing on Tuesday, November 14, 2023, at 9:00 am in Chief Judge Ingrid Bakke’s courtroom, Courtroom G, Division 13. Our office wanted to send out some reminders in advance of Tuesday.

In most felony cases where a defendant is being held in custody, the defendant is legally entitled to a Preliminary Hearing. The Preliminary Hearing is a limited hearing where the Judge, and not a jury, determines whether there is probable cause to believe that the defendant has committed certain offenses charged in the Complaint. While some evidence is discussed at a Preliminary Hearing, the hearing is not a “mini-trial.”
