Whether you have a smart cell phone, flip phone, or landline phone you may be receiving unwanted calls from telemarketers or scam calls. Either way here are some ways to limit the number of unwanted calls you receive.

For Smartphones

For iPhones

How to block robocalls on iPhones

- Go to the iPhone app and tap "Recents"
- Locate the number you would like to block
- Tap the blue "i" inside a circle to the right of the number
- On the next screen, scroll down and tap on "Block this caller"
- Tap on the option "Block Contact" on the message which pops up

iPhones - To make yourself unavailable to all numbers which are not on your Contacts list:

- Go to "Settings" and select the option "Phone"
- Scroll down
- Tap the "Silence Unknown Callers" switch, so it displays as green

For Android devices

To block a number on your Android device:

- Open the Phone app from the home screen
- Locate the tab "Recent" and tap on it
- Find the number you want to block, tap on it, and then tap the "i" in a circle
- Locate the "Block" button and confirm by hitting "Block" in the pop-up message

To block unknown numbers on your Android device:

- Open the Phone app from the home screen
- Locate three dots and tap on them to open a dropdown menu
- Select "Settings" from the list
- Tap on "Block Numbers"
- Toggle the "Block Unknown Callers" switch to green

For Landline Phones

General Blocking Anonymous Calls

- *77 to activate Anonymous Call Block (or dial 1177 on rotary or pulse-dialing phones) listen for a recording or confirmation tone
- *87 to deactivate Anonymous Call Block (or dial 1187 on rotary or pulse-dialing phones) listen for a recording or confirmation tone

CenturyLink – Blocking Anonymous Calls

- *78 or call 888-(Your Area Code)-8052
- The first time you Call CenturyLink Update Center, you're asked for a security code. You can enter the temporary security code "1-2-3-4", then follow the recorded instructions to set up your own personal code

Xfinity by Comcast – Spam Blocker

You can manage your spam blocking settings via your Xfinity Connect account.

- 1. Go to Xfinity Connect and click Voice at the top of the screen. (You may be directed to sign in first.)
- Click the Settings (wheel icon)in the upper-right corner and select Settings to see your voice preferences.
- 3. Select Call Blocking.
- 4. Adjust Spam Blocker settings accordingly.

Call Blocking Devices for Home Landlines

Installing a call blocking device can help you prevent becoming a victim of a scam. If your home phone does not use the internet (VoIP), you can purchase and install a call-blocking device.

Prevent Identity Theft

- Share as little information as possible:
 - Never share personal information like your Social Security Number or bank/credit information with anyone who calls you out of the blue, no matter who they say they are
 - Provide sensitive information over the phone
 ONLY when you initiate the contact and are certain whom you're calling
- Use different passwords for different accounts and do not share log-in information
- Check your credit report by visiting <u>www.annualcreditreport.com</u> or calling 1-877-322-8228
- Store and discard sensitive documents wisely by shredding or consider going paperless
- Opt out of telemarketing mail and calls to reduce the circulation of your information
 - Go to <u>www.optoutscreen.com</u> or call 1-888-567-8688 to opt out of insurance and credit card offers
 - Go to <u>www.dmachoice.org</u> to opt out of commercial mailings.
- Register for Do Not Call Registries
