
### **ELIGIBILITY**

- The head of household must be a U.S. citizen or a qualified alien.
- Household income must not exceed 80% of the Area Median Income (AMI)—visit our website for more information.
- The size of the household must match the size of the unit:
  - » Three-bedroom homes can house three to seven people.
  - » Four-bedroom homes can house four to nine people.

The Boulder County Housing Authority (BCHA) offers a variety of programs at Casa de la Esperanza to help residents learn new skills, get the help they need, and build a strong community.
