

Blue Envelope Program



The Blue Envelope Program improves communication between law enforcement and individuals with conditions that may impact communication such as autism spectrum disorders, dementia, hearing impairment, or language processing difficulties. Participants store essential documents in a bright blue envelope, signaling the potential need for additional communication accommodations during interactions with law enforcement. Participation is voluntary, there's no registry, and the envelopes are free.

How to Participate



If you would benefit from the Blue Envelope Program, pick up an envelope at the Boulder County Sheriff's Office Headquarters, one of our substations, or request one online.



Place your registration, proof of insurance, and optional information about communication challenges inside the blue envelope.



Hand the envelope to a deputy during traffic stops or other interactions.
