Measles Can Be Serious



1 out of every 1,000 people with measles will develop brain swelling due to infection (encephalitis), which may lead to brain damage.



1 or 2 out of 1,000 people with measles will die, even with the best care.



Measles Symptoms

If you have any of these symptoms, always call ahead before going to a medical provider, clinic, urgent care, or hospital.



High fever

Cough

Runny nose

Red, watery eyes

Rash starting on the face and spreading
