What is **NOT ALLOWED**?

All personal use, sale, and possession of fireworks are prohibited.



Any fire not within a permanently constructed fire pit, ring, or grate on PUBLIC land.



Stoves, BBQ's, grills, or lanterns that burn wood, charcoal, pellets, briquettes, or pressed logs on PUBLIC lands.



Smoking outdoors in an area not cleared of combustible material.



Slash pile burning through the Boulder County Open Burn Portal.



Recreational shooting on PUBLIC lands, including the use of explosive targets.



Using any internal or external combustion engine **WITHOUT** a spark-arresting device.

Welding or operating acetylene or other torch with open flame in an area that is **NOT** cleared at least 10 feet in diameter and **NOT** in possession of a chemical pressurized fire extinguisher.

What is **ALLOWED**?

Professional fireworks displays are allowed.



Fires contained within permanently constructed fire pit, ring or grate on PRIVATE land; or within a developed PUBLIC recreational site, such as approved campgrounds and picnic areas.



Devices that use gas, jellied petroleum, or pressurized liquid fuel and is equipped with an on/off switch on PUBLIC or PRIVATE land.



Smoking on PRIVATE property OR within an enclosed vehicle, building, developed recreation site, or in an area that is cleared of all combustible material on PUBLIC land.



Shooting or discharging firearms on PRIVATE land, at designated shooting range, or while hunting with valid and current hunting license.



Using internal or external combustion engines **WITH** a spark-arresting device.

Welding or operating acetylene or other torch with open flame in cleared areas of a least 10 feet in diameter and in possession of a chemical pressurized fire extinguisher.
