##### 2. Public Comment (5 min.)

1. Analisa – Advocating for accessibility, mobility for pedestrians and people with disability. Reached out to Town admin for accessibility improvements at Town Hall. Would like NEPPIDAC to help push for helpful changes and be a voice for accessibility; interested in sharing NEPPIDAC meetings more broadly with public. Asks about the protocol for inviting the public and promoting meetings by email.
2. Tierney – Shares outcomes from NEPPIDAC with Board of Trustees.

##### 4. Information Item: Mountain Rides Ridership Data (10 min.)

1. Q: Is there any threat to this being shut down?
  1. Via Mobility receives \$40K from CDOT to provide Mountain Rides service.
  1. Boulder County provides \$40K also (50% local match)

2. Mountain Mobility Working Group is seeking funding, looking at broad human services approach.
3. Sustainable long-term funding is in component of Countywide Strategic Transit Plan for further study.
4. Funding is dependent on FTA Rural Dollars

**5. Information Item: NEPPIDAC Project Eligibility (10 min.)**

1. NEPPIDAC has approx. \$340K to invest according to guidelines
  1. Current expenses include:
    1. Neighborhood EcoPass, Business EcoPass
    2. Administration of EcoPass programs by Town of Nederland
  2. Items related to transit are legitimate according to NEPPIDAC by-laws “on issues pertinent to the implementation of the public improvements serving the District.”
    1. Bus shelter improvements.
    2. Sidewalk gaps to transit.
    3. Additional transit service.
    4. Grant matches are legitimate if they will improve or enhance transit.
