ORC Ops Report:

- TIN Limit was not met
- Micro C dosing began to help with denitrification. It is a more expensive carbon source than methanol but allowed by CDPHE rules.

Invoices and Budget

- Additional McDonald Farms invoice.

New/Old Business:

- A Town Hall will be held at the fire house to discuss the JVA Engineering report and review three options to improve the facility to meet permit limits. The options include:
 - Implementing new technology within the existing tanks,
 - Consolidating with another facility, and
 - Optimizing the current facility.
- Before one of the three long-term options can be implemented, the plant is required to cease all permit violations immediately. Several small operational changes will be made in the interim. In addition to Micro C dosing, the plant will implement a clay flocculant to help settle suspended solids.
- A draft JVA report is expected to be ready by the 31st.
