Connect for Health Colorado offers a Special Enrollment Period. You may qualify for coverage — and help paying for it.

Tax-Time Enrollment Program

Available through April 15

When you file your Colorado taxes, check the health insurance box on your state tax form (DR 0104) if you don't currently have health coverage. Connect for Health Colorado will reach out to let you know if you qualify.

Life Changes. So Can Your Coverage.

Jan. 16–Oct. 31

Certain life events qualify you for a 60-day Special Enrollment Period to sign up for — or change — your health insurance plan.

Common qualifying events include:

Household changes

- Birth, adoption, or foster placement
- Pregnancy
- Marriage or divorce
- Death of a plan member
- Turning 26 and leaving a parent's plan

Loss of coverage

- Lost job-based insurance
- No longer qualify for Medicaid
- Loss of COBRA health coverage subsidy
- Your student plan ends


Move or status change

- Move to Colorado or a new permanent address
- Leaving incarceration
- Gaining lawful presence in the U.S.

Already enrolled?

Income changes

- A change that affects your eligibility for financial assistance
- If you no longer qualify for financial help due to an income change, you can change your plan
