- 2) To vote, fill in the oval next to your choice completely. Do not select more choices than allowed, or your vote for that contest will not be counted.
- 3) To vote for a certified write-in candidate, completely fill in the oval to the right of the words "Write-in" and write the name of a certified candidate on the line provided.
- 4) If you make a mistake while voting or tear your ballot, please call 303.413.7740 to request a replacement. See the Voter Instructions Insert for more information.



**! Return only one ballot.** If your mail ballot packet contains ballots for both the Democratic and Republican Parties, mark and return only one ballot and destroy the other. If you mark and return both party ballots, neither will count.

**WARNING:** Any person who, by use of force or other means, unduly influences an eligible elector to vote in any particular manner or to refrain from voting, or who falsely makes, alters, forges, or counterfeits any mail ballot before or after it has been cast, or who destroys, defaces, mutilates, or tampers with a ballot is subject, upon conviction, to imprisonment, or to a fine, or both.
