What is this study?

This study builds on earlier planning and community input. The project team is evaluating ways to make South Boulder Road safer and easier to use for people walking, biking, taking transit and driving.

This study is being led by Boulder County, in partnership with the cities of Boulder, Louisville, and Lafayette.



Why

Why is it important?

South Boulder Road connects people to neighborhoods, jobs, schools, businesses and other destinations. Today, parts of the road can feel difficult or unsafe to use. This study will recommend ways to improve safety, access and connections for people of all ages and abilities.

Where is South Boulder Road being studied?

The study covers about 9.5 miles, from the intersection of Table Mesa Drive and Broadway in Boulder to South Boulder Road and 120th Street in Lafayette. The study area passes through Boulder, unincorporated Boulder County, Louisville and Lafayette.



When will the study be finished?

The study will take place in three phases. During each phase, the project team will share information, gather community input and use what it learns to refine the work.
